On the page 25 of document 10349/14 INIT, footnote 30 should read as follows:

HU **and PL** have serious concerns; the proposed general clause (“a legally binding instrument”) is too vague because the text does not define its content. Furthermore, the text does not provide for previous examination by the DPA either. HU therefore suggests either deleting this point or subjecting such instrument to the authorisation of the DPA, as it believes that there is a real risk that transfers based on such a vague instrument might seriously undermine the rights of the data subjects.
