Subject:	Proposal for a Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council amending Regulation (EU, Euratom) No 966/2012 as regards the financing of European political parties (first reading)
	 Adoption of the legislative act (LA+S)

- 1. On 7 December 2012 <u>the Commission</u> sent the above proposal¹, based on Article 322 TFEU and Article 106a of the Euratom Treaty, to the Council.
- 2. <u>The Court of Auditors</u> delivered its opinion on 7 February 2013^2 .
- 3. In accordance with the provisions of the Joint Declaration on practical arrangements for the codecision procedure³, informal contacts were initiated between the Council, the European Parliament and the Commission with the aim of reaching agreement at first reading.
- <u>The European Parliament</u> adopted its position at first reading on the Commission proposal on 16 April 2014. The outcome of voting in the European Parliament reflects the compromise agreement reached between the institutions and should, therefore, be acceptable to the Council⁴.

- 5. The Permanent Representatives Committee is therefore asked to confirm its agreement and to suggest that the Council:
 - approve the European Parliament's position, as set out in PE-CONS 68/14, as an "A" item at a forthcoming meeting, with the Netherlands and United Kingdom delegations voting against;
 - order that the statement in the <u>addendum</u> to this note be entered in the minutes of that meeting.

If the Council approves the European Parliament's position, the legislative act will be adopted.

After being signed by the President of the European Parliament and the President of the Council, the legislative act will be published in the Official Journal of the European Union.
