Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 1612/68 of 15 October 1968 on freedom of movement for workers within the Community ¹, and in particular Articles 26 and 27 thereof,

Whereas:

- (1) By its Decision of 28 June 2004 ², the Council appointed the members and alternate members of the Advisory Committee on Freedom of Movement for Workers for the period ending on 6 May 2006.
- (2) A member's seat and an alternate member's seat on that Committee in the government representatives category have fallen vacant as a result of the resignations of Ms Piret LILLEVÄLI and Ms Maarja SAKS.
