



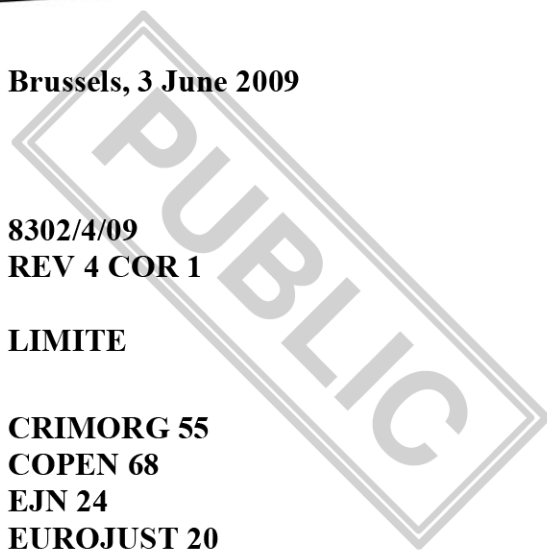

Subject :	Final report on the fourth round of mutual evaluations - The practical application of the European Arrest Warrant and corresponding surrender procedures between Member States

On page 14, third paragraph of doc. 8302/4/09 REV 4 should read as follows:

“In addition, during many evaluations experts noted concerns in some Member States regarding the appropriate legal basis for the execution of sentences in accordance with Article 4(6) of the Framework Decision and, linked thereto, the possibility that a surrender for the purpose of enforcement a sentence may be refused while at the same time the judicial authority of the executing Member State sees no sufficient legal basis for enforcing the sentence in the executing Member State”.
