Subject :	Proposal for a Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council laying down the obligations of operators who place timber and timber products on the market

	– Approval of the European Parliament's amendment (LA + S)

- On 17 October 2008 <u>the Commission</u> sent the above proposal¹, based on Article 175(1) of the TEC, to the Council. Following the entry into force of the Treaty of Lisbon, the proposal must be adopted on the basis of Article 192(1) of the TFEU.
- 2. <u>The European Economic and Social Committee</u> delivered its opinion on 1 October 2009².
- 3. <u>The European Parliament</u> delivered its opinion at first reading on 22 April 2009³.

- 4. On 1 March 2010 <u>the Council</u> adopted its position at first reading¹ and forwarded it, with a statement of its reasons, to the European Parliament.
- 5. In accordance with the provisions of the Joint Declaration on practical arrangements for the codecision procedure², informal contacts were initiated between the Council, the European Parliament and the Commission with the aim of reaching agreement at second reading.
- At its sitting on 7 July 2010, <u>the Parliament</u> adopted, at second reading, one amendment to the Council's position at first reading. That amendment reflects the compromise agreement between the three institutions and should therefore be acceptable to the Council³.
- <u>The Commission</u> issued its opinion on the European Parliament's amendment on 30 August 2010⁴.
- 8. <u>The Permanent Representatives Committee</u> is therefore asked to confirm its agreement on this amendment and to suggest that the Council:
 - approve the European Parliament's amendment contained in 11756/10, as set out after legal/linguistic revision in PE-CONS 33/10, as an "A" item on the agenda for a forthcoming meeting, with the Swedish delegation voting against and the Czech and Portuguese delegations abstaining;
 - decide to enter the statements set out in <u>the addendum</u> to this note in the minutes of that meeting.
- Following approval by the Council of the European Parliament's amendment, the Regulation is deemed to have been adopted in the form of the Council's position at first reading thus amended, in conformity with Article 294(8)(a) of the TFEU.

After being signed by the President of the European Parliament and the President of the Council, the legislative act will be published in the Official Journal of the European Union
