- On 7 November 2011 <u>the Commission</u> sent the above proposal¹, based on Article 207 TFEU, to the Council.
- 2. <u>The European Parliament</u> adopted its position at first reading on 23 October 2012^2 .

- 3. At its 3292nd meeting on 11 February 2014, <u>the General Affairs Council</u> reached political agreement on the Council's position at first reading on the above Regulation¹.
- 4. <u>The Permanent Representatives Committee</u> is asked to suggest that the Council:
 - adopt, as an "A" item on the agenda for a forthcoming meeting, the Council's position at first reading as set out in 18086/13 and the statement of reasons as set out in 18086/13 ADD 1;
 - order that the statement in the <u>addendum</u> to this note be entered in the minutes of that meeting and published in the Official Journal of the European Union together with the legislative act.
